

Volunteer Positions

Seller (18 +) – If you love to meet new people this is a great role for you!

You will check-in at the Rotary office and be provided with a sales apron, ticket pouch, float and a lunch. When you arrive at your sales booth just reach out to the crowd and offer them the opportunity to purchase Dream Home or Split'Em 50 tickets.

You are responsible for sharing ticket prices, some prize details and managing the payments from patrons. A tip sheet for the Moneris Credit and Debit machine is available in the booth and your Sales Manager will check in with you throughout the shift to provide support and answer your questions.

At the end of your shift, return to the Rotary Office to cash out your tickets and payments, support is provided in the office. This process can take 30 to 60 minutes and then you are free to go.

Printer (14+) – A little shy, not a sales type or under 18? Consider assisting as a printer.

Check in with our office and grab a lunch, then head for your booth.

The Printing software is pretty foolproof and all you need to do is type the patron's personal details into the template and click print. Ticket sheets can be split so you can put 2 names on each sheet in the event 2 patrons have shared a ticket package.

Common issues in this role, printer jams and power cables coming loose. There is a dedicated tech team on site to help if you cannot manage on your own.

At the end of your shift:

Day – you will remain in the booth until relieved by the next shift.

Night – please remain in the booth until the sales booth closest to you has been closed and all patrons have had their tickets printed.

You do not need to return to the office to check out.

Runner – Don't like to be caged in a booth? Want a work out while you volunteer, sign up here!

Runners for the Dream Home project provide many services to the volunteers and our organizing committee, no day will be the same as the last.

Key Responsibilities:

- Get stuff to the booths when they need it, tickets, food and beverages, supplies

- Take a few pictures, we want all of our volunteers to appear on our photo reel
- Assist the Sales Manager with ticket pick up and sort
- Support the Shift Supervisor with office clean up and replenishing coolers

You will be asked to walk/run/hop through large crowds, wear your comfy boots as this role logs about 10 km per shift and you will be dodging strollers the whole way.

Must be able to lift and carry up to 50 lbs around the park during ticket pick-ups once per shift.

Host – This role is responsible for welcoming patrons to the Dream Home and ensuring that food, beverages and baby strollers are left outside....our winner doesn't want lemonade splattered on the wall.

You will also ensure that the lovely furnishings and décor items do not go missing during the public tours.

Your Role, be friendly, welcome guests and watch for potential theft. You will have a radio if you need assistance.
